GEOPHYSICS PROGRAM TO BEGIN AT LUMINARIA, PERU

Vancouver, Canada – Tinka Resources Limited (the “Company”) - (TSXv - TK; Frankfurt – TLD; Pinksheets-TKRFF).

Mr. Andrew Carter, President, is pleased to report that a contract has been signed to undertake an Induced Polarization and Magnetic Survey (the “Survey”) over the known gold mineralization within the Company’s Luminaria Project in central Peru. The Survey, which will commence this week, consists of 12 line kilometres covering an area of about 1,400 metres by 800 metres and is expected to take approximately 14 days to complete.
